



# SCQF: SCHOOLS NEWSLETTER

## CREDIT WHERE CREDIT'S DUE LEAFLET – INFO FOR PARENTS AND CARERS


Help get parents and carers up to speed with all things SCQF with our Credit Where Credit's Due leaflet. A useful resource to hand out at parents' evenings.
