

## SCQF DATABASE

In order to be on the SCQF, all qualifications have to go through a rigorous, quality assured process of credit rating by an SCQF Credit Rating Body (CRB). CRBs include colleges, universities and other Higher Education Institutions, the Scottish Qualifications Authority (SQA) and a limited number of other organisations which are approved directly by the SCQF Partnership to credit rate.

The information available on the SCQF Database includes the SCQF level of the qualification, the number of SCQF credit points that can be achieved, and the target audience.

It is important to note when accessing our database that not everything delivered in Scotland is included because, due to its voluntary nature, not all qualifications are on the SCQF (see the presentation for information about this). The database does not hold any information about the content of qualifications, number of places available, start dates, providers etc. Some data is only updated periodically. 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## QUALIFICATIONS CAN CROSS BOUNDARIES LEAFLET

The Qualifications Can Cross Boundaries leaflet provides information that allows you to look at the way qualifications are organised in the UK and Ireland. It allows you to draw broad comparisons in terms of the level of challenge (rather than direct equivalences) between qualifications and their levels for each country in the UK and in Ireland.

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## THE RPL TOOL



