The Scottish Credit and Qualifications Framework (SCQF) Database allows you to search the range of Scottish qualifications that are credit rated on the SCQF and easily compare how they relate to each other.

Recent updates to the Database, which is managed by the SCQF Partnership, have made it an even more useful tool for schools. Improved search functionality means details of the many and varied qualifications recognised on the SCQF can be accessed with the click of a button. For each learning programme, the Database clearly displays the level at which it sits on the Framework, the number of credit points it is worth and who owns it.

There are many reasons to use this resource, with benefits for school staff and young people. The Database can be used as...

A SUPPORT TOOL FOR SCHOOLS

- To help recognise the full range of achievements gained by young people, in line with Insight (Scottish Government's benchmarking tool for the senior phase)
- Assists in broadening the learning experience of young people to ensure progression of all learners, a measure outlined in Education Scotland's *How Good is Our School?* (HGIOS) document
- Helps schools plan and facilitate learning pathways, a key component of the Scottish Government's Developing the Young Workforce programme
- Promotes the understanding of the equivalence of different types of qualification/learning programme across SCQF levels

A GUIDE FOR LEARNERS

- Helps them understand the level of learning they have achieved, increasing confidence and self esteem
- Helps them recognise the benefits of undertaking vocational qualifications e.g. the Outward Bound Adventure and Challenge Award
- Helps them plan their learning journey and recognises their wider achievements
