Develop the ability to explain SCQF in a simple and engaging way verbally and in writing, through social media, newsletters and presentations



Public speaking

Deliver presentations at school events, speak confidently about SCQF, and answer questions from students, teachers, and parents.



Organisation

Plan and manage activities like workshops, school events, and collaborative projects with neighbouring schools, ensuring clear timelines and responsibilities.
